

CHAPTER 13 – MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AND OFFENSES

Sec. 13-96. Noise; noise sensitive areas

(a) The owner of a School, Courts, Churches, Hospitals, Funeral Homes, Cemeteries and Skilled Care Institutions may file an application with the Community Development Director requesting the creation of a Noise Sensitive Area consisting of a buffer of not more than 500 feet surrounding the exterior boundaries of the property. The Community Development Department may charge a fee for such applications in the amount provided in Chapter 2 of this Code.

(1) For purposes of schools and courts, the owner is defined as the Superintendent of the District or the Chief Administrative Officer of the political subdivision that operates the Court.

(b) The Community Development Director shall verify that the application is from a qualified use and that the applicant agrees to pay the cost for the installation and maintenance of all signage installed by the City designating the zone.
