

CHAPTER 14 – MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Sec. 14-27. Police Department; annual traffic safety report.

(a) The Police Department shall annually prepare a traffic report which shall be filed with the City Manager. Such report shall contain information on traffic matters in the city as follows:

- (1) The number of traffic accidents, the number of fatalities, the number of persons injured and other pertinent traffic accident data.
- (2) The number of traffic accidents investigated and other pertinent data on the safety activities of the police chief.
- (3) The plans and recommendations of the Police Department for future traffic safety activities.

(b) Whenever the accidents at any particular location become numerous the chief of police shall refer the location and matter to the City Engineer who may conduct studies of such accidents and determine remedial measures.
